

1 [Changing Official Width of Sidewalk]

3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks"**  
4 **by adding thereto Section 15\_\_ to change the official sidewalk width on the west side**  
5 **of Masonic north of Haight Street; making findings pursuant to the General Plan and**  
6 **Planning Code Section 101.1; and requiring relocation, modification, or both of**  
7 **facilities affected by the sidewalk width changes.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference  
14 herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter  
15 dated 2003, which stated that the actions contemplated herein are consistent  
16 with the General Plan and Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of  
17 such letter is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. \_\_\_\_\_.

18 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. \_\_\_\_\_, a  
19 copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. \_\_\_\_\_, Board of  
20 Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks," a copy of  
21 which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May  
22 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

23 Section 15 . The width of sidewalks on the west side of Masonic north of Haight Street shall  
24 be modified as shown on Department of Public Works drawing O- - , a copy of which is in the  
25 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. \_\_\_\_\_.

1 Section 3. JC Decaux San Francisco, Inc., the project sponsor who proposes to  
2 undertake the sidewalk construction to implement the sidewalk width changes, is required to  
3 make arrangements with public utilities and City Departments concerning relocation,  
4 modification, or both of facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas. Any necessary  
5 relocation, modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and County of  
6 San Francisco.
