15 (PA); licensed Real Estate Broker; Attorney; or a Property Appraiser accredited by a nationally
16 recognized professional organization, or Property Appraiser certified by the Office of Real
17 Estate Appraiser; or he or she is a current member of an assessment appeals board, for a
18 three-year term ending September 3, 2007.

19 Mervin Conlan, succeeding himself, term expiring September 6, 2004, seat 3, must
20 meet the eligibility criteria set forth in Section 1624.05 of the California Revenue and Taxation
21 Code: Must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of California as
22 one of the following: Certified Public Accountant (CPA) or Public Accountant (PA); licensed
23 Real Estate Broker; Attorney; or a Property Appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized
24 professional organization, or Property Appraiser certified by the Office of Real Estate

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1 Appraiser; or he or she is a current member of an assessment appeals board, for a three-year
2 term ending September 3, 2007.

3 Richard Lee, succeeding Donald Schmidt, term expiring September 6, 2004, seat 4,
4 must meet the eligibility criteria set forth in Section 1624.05 of the California Revenue and
5 Taxation Code: Must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of
6 California as one of the following: Certified Public Accountant (CPA) or Public Accountant
7 (PA); licensed Real Estate Broker; Attorney; or a Property Appraiser accredited by a nationally
8 recognized professional organization, or Property Appraiser certified by the Office of Real
9 Estate Appraiser; or he or she is a current member of an assessment appeals board, for a
10 three-year term ending September 3, 2007.

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
