RESOLUTION NO. 10-0139

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) and the National Park Service (NPS) desire to continue their cooperation in their common goal and acknowledge the SFPUC's financial commitment and the NPS' implementation commitment to watershed protection, environmental stewardship and security programs; and


WHEREAS, services are anticipated to begin in July 2010 and end in June 2015 and the total duration of this agreement is 60 months; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost over 5-years is \$30,000,000; and

WHEREAS, funds will be available upon adoption of the Hetch Hetchy annual operating budget each year; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Commission hereby authorizes the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of the Interior, Yosemite National Park for an amount not to exceed \$30,000,000, and with a total duration of sixty (60) months for watershed protection, environmental stewardship and security.
