

1 [State grant to expand homeless services to the mentally ill.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Community**
4 **Behavioral Health Services (SFDPH, CBHS) to accept retroactively and expend a grant**
5 **in the amount of \$423,964 from the California Department of Mental Health (CDMH) to**
6 **expand homeless services to the mentally ill; for the period of July 1, 2004, to June 30,**
7 **2005.**

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9 WHEREAS, SFDPH, CBHS has applied for and been awarded a grant of federal funds
10 through CDMH in the amount of \$423,964 to expand homeless services to the mentally ill;
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, Funds for this grant are federally authorized under the Stewart B.
13 McKinney Homeless Assistance Amendments Act of 1990, which provides funds for the
14 provision of services to the homeless mentally ill; and,

15 WHEREAS, SFDPH, CBHS has received this funding since 1991; and,

16 WHEREAS, SFDPH, CBHS has received an award letter for this grant; and,

17 WHEREAS, A copy of the grant Application and the State allocation worksheet is
18 enclosed in this package; and,

19 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$8,667; and,

20 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
21 because the grant award letter was not available until too late to obtain approval of the Board
22 of Supervisors prior to the start date of the grant; and,

23 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
24 may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually

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1 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
2 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That SFDPH, CBHS is hereby authorized to accept and expend
4 retroactively a grant in the amount of \$423,964 from CDMH; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
6 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Application, pursuant to San
7 Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 CDMH agreement on behalf of the City.
