2 URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO TAXI COMMISSION TO SEEK OPTIONS FOR
3 EXTENDING TAXI SERVICE DURING THE 1999 HALLOWEEN CELEBRATION,
4 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO WAIVING PERMITS FOR THE SPECIFIED PERIOD SO
5 THAT ALL INSPECTED VEHICLES, INCLUDING SPARE VEHICLES, COULD BE UTILIZED
6 AS TAXIS THAT NIGHT.

8 WHEREAS, San Francisco's renowned Halloween celebration located in the Civic
9 Center and Castro attracts residents from neighborhoods throughout the city and tourists from
10 all over the world, the nation, and the Bay Area; and

11 WHEREAS, The celebration ends at 2:00 a.m. on November 1, at which time
12 thousands of people are in need of safe, affordable, efficient means of transportation to their
13 homes; and,

14 WHEREAS, Taxis provide one such alternative and are viewed as an extension of the
15 public transportation system; and

16 WHEREAS, Extending taxi service that evening would encourage visitors not to drive
17 their own cars into the congested areas and would give them a safe, efficient option for
18 getting to and from their homes; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors does
20 hereby urge the Taxi Commission to seek options for extending taxi service on Halloween
21 Night 1999, including but not limited to waiving permits for the specified period so that all
22 inspected vehicles, including spare vehicles, could be utilized as taxis that night; and be it


