2 AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE  
3 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A  
4 GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,280,786 IN REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION  
5 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS FOR VARIOUS TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL  
6 PROJECTS.

8 WHEREAS, S.B. 45 (Chapter 622, Statutes 1997) substantially  
9 revised the process for estimating the amount of state and federal  
10 funds available for transportation projects in the state for  
11 appropriating and allocating the available funds to these projects;  
12 and,

13 WHEREAS, As part of that new process, the Metropolitan  
14 Transportation Commission (MTC) is responsible for programming  
15 projects eligible for Regional Transportation Improvement Program  
16 (RTIP) funds, pursuant to Government Code Section 14527(b), for  
17 inclusion in the Regional Transportation Improvement Program, and  
18 submission to the California Transportation Commission, for inclusion  
19 in the State Transportation Improvement Program; and

20 WHEREAS, MTC has requested eligible transportation project  
21 sponsors to submit applications nominating projects to be programmed  
22 for RTIP funds in the 2000 Regional Transportation Improvement  
23 Program, and

24 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority,  
25 acting as Congestion Management Agency, has recommended the

1 programming of a total of \$1,153,000 for the Department of Public  
2 Works' (DPW's) Fourth Street Bridge Seismic Retrofit and  
3 Rehabilitation Project (\$953,000) and Illinois Street  
4 Project (\$200,000); and

5 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority has  
6 also recommended the programming of a total of \$127,786 in RTIP funds  
7 to act as local match to the federal Congestion Management and Air  
8 Quality (CMAQ) grants already programmed for the Panhandle Path  
9 Lighting and Kezar Drive/3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue/Lincoln Way Rechannelization  
10 Project (\$92,000), the Alemany and San Jose Signal Timing Project  
11 (\$15,026), and the Upper Market Signal Timing Project (\$20,760); and,

12 WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission adopted Resolution  
13 No. 168-99-PTC at its meeting of September 7, 1999 authorizing the  
14 Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic or his  
15 designee to execute documents necessary to apply for retroactively,  
16 accpet and expend up to \$127,786 in Transportation Equity Act for the  
17 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act (TEA21) Congestion Management and Air Quality match  
18 funds to light the Panhandle Path, rechannel the Kezar Drive/3<sup>rd</sup>  
19 Ave./Lincoln Way intersection, and retime traffic signals on Alemany  
20 Blvd., San Jose Ave., and uppur Market St., and

21 WHEREAS, The State of California reimburses for indirect  
22 (administrative) costs under the Regional Transportation Improvement  
23 Program; and


24 WHEREAS, Eligible indirect costs will be claimed at applicable  
25 departmental rates; and



2 RTIP, now, therefore be it


3 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize




