2 **AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**
3 **OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND**
4 **EXPEND UP TO \$2,976,264 IN FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION**
5 **PROGRAM/CONGESTION MANAGEMENT AND AIR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**
6 **FUNDS WITH REQUIRED LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS OF \$342,270 FOR**
7 **TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL PROJECTS.**

8 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority has
9 recommended the programming of \$1,958,264 in federal Surface
10 Transportation Program/Congestion Management and Air Quality
11 Improvement Program (STP/CMAQ) funds for the Department of Public
12 Works' (DPW's) pavement renovation project of Lake Merced Boulevard,
13 as part of the upcoming 1999 Transportation Improvement Program, to
14 be adopted by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission and approved
15 by the Federal Highway Administration; and,

16 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority has
17 recommended the programming a total of \$708,000 in STP/CMAQ funds for
18 the Department of Parking and Traffic's (DPT's) Golden Gate Park
19 Kezar Drive Path/Lincoln Way/Kezar Drive/3rd Avenue and Panhandle Path
20 Improvements and \$310,000 in STP/CMAQ funds for the Brotherhood
21 Way/Alemanly Blvd./Orizaba Avenue Intersection Project; and,

22 WHEREAS, The federal funding will cover 88.5 percent of eligible
23 costs, as defined by the Federal Highway Administration and
24 administered by the California Department of Transportation; and,

1 WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible, according to Federal
2 Highway Administration rules and regulations; and,


3 WHEREAS, The non-federal share will be paid for with local half-
4 cent sales tax administered by the San Francisco County
5 Transportation Authority and other locally-available funds totaling
6 \$342,270; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize
8 the Director of Public Works and the Executive Director of the
9 Department of Parking and Traffic to apply for, accept and expend up
10 to \$2,976,264 in federal Surface Transportation program funds with
11 required local matching funds of \$342,270 for the aforementioned
12 public works and traffic projects and to execute any and all
13 documents necessary therefor.




