AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND UP TO \$2,976,264 IN FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM/CONGESTION MANAGEMENT AND AIR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS WITH REQUIRED LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS OF \$342,270 FOR TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority has recommended the programming of \$1,958,264 in federal Surface Transportation Program/Congestion Management and Air Quality Improvement Program (STP/CMAQ) funds for the Department of Public Works' (DPW's) pavement renovation project of Lake Merced Boulevard, as part of the upcoming 1999 Transportation Improvement Program, to be adopted by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission and approved by the Federal Highway Administration; and,

WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority has recommended the programming a total of \$708,000 in STP/CMAQ funds for the Department of Parking and Traffic's (DPT's) Golden Gate Park Kezar Drive Path/Lincoln Way/Kezar Drive/3rd Avenue and Panhandle Path Improvements and \$310,000 in STP/CMAQ funds for the Brotherhood Way/Alemany Blvd./Orizaba Avenue Intersection Project; and,

WHEREAS, The federal funding will cover 88.5 percent of eligible costs, as defined by the Federal Highway Administration and administered by the California Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible, according to Federal Highway Administration rules and regulations; and,

WHEREAS, The non-federal share will be paid for with local half-cent sales tax administered by the San Francisco County

Transportation Authority and other locally-available funds totaling

\$342,270; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Director of Public Works and the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic to apply for, accept and expend up to \$2,976,264 in federal Surface Transportation program funds with required local matching funds of \$342,270 for the aforementioned public works and traffic projects and to execute any and all documents necessary therefor.
