AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO APPLY FOR GRANT SUPPORT FROM THE TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR IN THE BAY AREA FOR PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS TO REDUCE AIR POLLUTION FROM MOTOR VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 434 created the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the San Francisco Bay Area and provided authority to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (the District) to impose up to a \$4.00 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees within its jurisdiction, to be used to implement specified transportation control measures included in the District's 1991 Bay Area Clean Air Plan; and

WHEREAS, The District is seeking applications from Bay Area cities, counties, school districts, transit districts, and other agencies to cover the costs of transportation programs and projects that achieve emission reductions from motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports the Bay Area Clean Air Plan; and

WHEREAS, The following City departments have developed programs and projects eligible for AB 434/TFCA program funding;

Department of Parking and Traffic

To establish additional bike lanes in various locations at a (TFCA) cost of approximately \$300,000.

San Francisco Municipal Railway

For additional funding support for MUNI's proposed Alternative Fuel Demonstration Project to evaluate two diesel-hybrid electric coaches in MUNI revenue service in the amount of approximately \$1,000,000.

Supervisor Ammiano

Department of Administrative Services/Heavy Duty Vehicle Project #1

To convert 9 concrete mixer trucks from 3 San Francisco companies with contract relationships and displacement/relocation issues with the City and County of San Francisco, to CNG dual-fuel. TFCA funding request totals approximately \$380,000.

<u>Department of Administrative Services/Office of the City Administrator/Heavy</u> <u>Duty Vehicle Project #2</u>

In partnership with Waste Management, Inc., the City and County of San Francisco is proposing to purchase 12 heavy duty vehicles fueled by CNG or liquified natural gas (LNG), depending on availability. TFCA funding request totals approximately \$500,000.

Office of the City Administrator/Department of Administrative Services/Heavy Duty Vehicle Project #3

In partnership with Norcal Waste Systems, Inc., the City and County of San Francisco will replace at least 14 heavy duty transfer trucks with vehicles operating on LNG. The total TFCA request for this project is expected to be approximately \$1,000,000.

WHEREAS, The District requires all applications to be authorized by the applicant's governing board, or in this case, the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, An accept and expend resolution will still be required (at a later date) by the Board of Supervisors, in the event that any of these projects are designated for District funding awards; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Director of the Department of Administrative Services, on behalf of various City departments, is authorized to apply for funding support from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air for programs to reduce air pollution from motor vehicles.
