EXTENDING CONDOLENCES AND EXPRESSING SYMPATHY AND CONCERN FOR THE EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS IN TAIWAN, URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO COMMUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN HUMANITARIAN AID EFFORTS, AND DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO FORWARD A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE TAIPEI ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL OFFICE, THE CITY OF TAIPEI, AND THE GOVERNMENT OF TAIWAN.

WHEREAS, An earthquake measuring 7.6 in magnitude struck ninety miles south of Taipei, Taiwan on September 21, 1999; and,

WHEREAS, Preliminary reports estimate that 1,123 people were killed and over 3,500 were injured, with another 1200 others trapped under rubble; and,

WHEREAS, The earthquake caused widespread devastation including wrecking a 12-story hotel in Taipei which trapped 131 persons inside; and,

WHEREAS, Taipei has been San Francisco's official "sister city" for 29 years; and,

WHEREAS, Approximately 200,000 Bay Area residents have family ties to Taiwan; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco is deeply saddened by the loss of life and injuries caused by the recent earthquake; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco hereby extends it condolences and expresses sympathy and concern for the earthquake victims in Taiwan; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the San Francisco community to participate in humanitarian aid efforts; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco hereby directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to forward a copy of this resolution to the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office, the City of Taipei, and the government of Taiwan.
