Overview of Agreement



Reducing Overdose through Community Approaches Mentorship Program:

- **Funder:** Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- **Third Party Administrator:** National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO)
- **Amount:** Anticipated revenue of \$98,999
- **Timeline:** July 1, 2023 – July 31, 2024
- **Project:** Mentorship, leadership, consulting and technical assistance
- **Resolution:** Requesting authority for DPH to retroactively accept nonstandard terms in the grant agreement with NACCHO

Overview of Services



SFDPH will provide technical assistance and capacity building to local jurisdictions regarding overdose prevention. NACCHO will pay SFDPH for services completed. Funds will support the following activities:

- **Focus Groups:**

- Incentive cards for participation in focus groups to enhance overdose prevention activities

- **Naloxone Boxes:**

- Boxes to stock emergency doses of naloxone

- **Outreach Supplies:**

- Supplies for staff conducting outreach in community settings, including face shields, naloxone pouches, etc.

Non-Standard Terms in Agreement and Retroactivity



Non-standard terms in Agreement:

- Enter into agreement with NACCHO for **funding** of \$98,999
- Obligates the City to agree to **binding arbitration**

Retroactivity:

- SFDPH is seeking retroactive authorization to accept non-standard terms in NACCHO agreement, which DPH received on April 10, 2024.
- After discussions between the City Attorney's Office and NACCHO, DPH decided to accept the non-standard terms in the agreement.

DPH respectfully requests retroactive approval of this item.
