# Reducing Overdose through Community Approaches Mentorship Program:

- Funder: Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- Third Party Administrator: National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO)
- Amount: Anticipated revenue of \$98,999
- Timeline: July 1, 2023 July 31, 2024
- Project: Mentorship, leadership, consulting and technical assistance
- Resolution: Requesting authority for DPH to retroactively accept nonstandard terms in the grant agreement with NACCHO

#### **Overview of Services**



SFDPH will provide technical assistance and capacity building to local jurisdictions regarding overdose prevention. NACCHO will pay SFDPH for services completed. Funds will support the following activities:

#### Focus Groups:

• Incentive cards for participation in focus groups to enhance overdose prevention activities

#### Naloxone Boxes:

Boxes to stock emergency doses of naloxone

#### Outreach Supplies:

• Supplies for staff conducting outreach in community settings, including face shields, naloxone pouches, etc.

# Non-Standard Terms in Agreement and Retroactivity



#### **Non-standard terms in Agreement:**

- Enter into agreement with NACCHO for funding of \$98,999
- Obligates the City to agree to binding arbitration

#### **Retroactivity:**

- SFDPH is seeking retroactive authorization to accept non-standard terms in NACCHO agreement, which DPH received on April 10, 2024.
- After discussions between the City Attorney's Office and NACCHO, DPH decided to accept the non-standard terms in the agreement.

DPH respectfully requests retroactive approval of this item.
