APPROVING THE CONVEYANCE OF LAND BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF

THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

FOR THE FEDERAL OFFICE BUILDING PROJECT IN IMPLEMENTATION OF THE

REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE FEDERAL OFFICE BUILDING PROJECT AREA; AND

ADOPTING FINDINGS PURSUANT TO SECTION 33433 OF THE CALIFORNIA

COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT LAW.

WHEREAS, The Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco (the "Agency") prepared and approved the Redevelopment Plan for the Federal Office Building Redevelopment Project Area (the "Redevelopment Plan") in accordance with the requirements of the Community Redevelopment Law (Sections 33000 et seq. of the Health and Safety Code), and the Board of Supervisors adopted the Redevelopment Plan on October 14, 1997; and

WHEREAS, The Agency acquired land within the Federal Office Building
Redevelopment Project Area (the "Project Area") using tax increment funds from the Golden
Gateway Redevelopment Project Area and the South of Market Earthquake Recovery
Redevelopment Project Area pursuant to the fiscal merger of the project areas approved by
the Board of Supervisors on October 14, 1997; and

WHEREAS, The Agency proposes to enter into that certain Real Property Conveyance Agreement (a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. ______) with the United States of America acting by and through the General Services Administration ("GSA"), whereby the Agency will convey certain land to GSA at no cost for the purpose of constructing an approximately 675,000 gross square foot federal administrative office building; and

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SUPERVISOR YAKI BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, On August 7, 2000, this Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No.

196-00 ordering the vacation of a portion of Jessie Street and approving the conveyance thereof to the Agency at no cost, subject to the terms and conditions of the Agreement for Transfer of Real Estate between the City and the Agency, a copy of which is also on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No.001153;

WHEREAS, Section 33220 of the Health and Safety Code authorizes, among other things, the City to sell or convey City-owned property within a redevelopment project area to the Redevelopment Agency with or without consideration for the purpose of aiding and cooperating in the undertaking and construction of redevelopment projects; and

WHEREAS, Section 33433 of the Health and Safety Code requires the Board of Supervisors, as the legislative body under Section 33433, to approve the Agency's sale of any land acquired with tax increment proceeds for development pursuant to the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with the requirements of Section 33433, the Agency has published a notice and made available a report (the "Report") regarding the proposed conveyance of land to GSA; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors hereby finds, determines and declares, based on the record before it, including but not limited to the analyses and information contained in the Report that:

- A. The proposed conveyance of land to GSA pursuant to the proposed Real Property

 Conveyance Agreement between the Agency and GSA will assist in the elimination

 of blight from the Project Area;
- B. The proposed conveyance of land to GSA is consistent with the implementation plan adopted pursuant to Section 33490 of the Health and Safety Code for the Project Area; and

C. The consideration is not less than the fair reuse value at the use and with the covenants and conditions and development costs authorized by the proposed Real Property Conveyance Agreement between the Agency and GSA.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the proposed Real Property Conveyance Agreement between the Agency and GSA and the transactions contemplated thereby.
