12	caused by tobacco sales and marketing, especially in our marginalized and vulnerable			
13	communities, through the enforcement of tobacco control laws; and			
14	WHEREAS, In partnership with San Francisco tobacco retailers, community, San			
15	Francisco Police Department and City Attorney's Office, DPH will continue to prevent youth			
16	access to flavored tobacco and nicotine products, including through online sales; and			
17	WHEREAS, DPH will maintain data collection, analysis, and reporting to its partners for			
18	the evaluation of the program's effectiveness; and			
19	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and			
20	WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received			
21	the award letter on October 11, 2023, for a project start date of January 1, 2024; and			
22	WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of			
23	\$137,530; now, therefore, be it			
24	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant			
25	in the amount of \$2,888,144 from the DOJ; and, be it			

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and

3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
