Resolution retroactively authorizing the Director of Health to execute a grant agreement, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, with the California Board of State and Community Corrections for participation in the Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion Pilot Program, for the period of July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2019, for a total amount of \$5,900,000.

WHEREAS, On June 27, 2016, California State Senate Bill 843 established the Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) Pilot Program to be administered by the California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC); and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the LEAD Pilot Program is to improve public safety and use of social service resources while reducing costs to law enforcement agencies and courts stemming from repeated incarceration; and

WHEREAS, The Workgroup to Re-envision the Jail Replacement Project prioritized the need for implementing LEAD in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Based on a model developed in Seattle, LEAD Pilot Programs are innovative pre-booking diversion programs that refer repeat, low-level drug offenders, at the earliest contact with law enforcement, to community-based health and social services as an alternative to jail and prosecution; and

WHEREAS, On February 1, 2017, the Mayor's Office submitted an application to the BSCC to participate in the LEAD Pilot Program, to be called LEAD SF in San Francisco, and designated the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) as the lead agency (See, Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion San Francisco (LEAD SF) Grant Application on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 170689); and

WHEREAS, LEAD SF Program participants will have access to the city's extensive system of care that includes comprehensive behavioral health services (substance use disorder and mental health treatment), physical health services, transitional housing, employment, and other relevant services; and

WHEREAS, LEAD SF will build on existing City and County efforts to address the complex needs of repeat drug and alcohol offenders through a multi-agency, collaborative initiative based on shared planning, decision-making, data sharing, and evaluation; and

WHEREAS, On April 20, 2017, the Mayor's Office was notified that it was awarded \$5,900,000 in funding from the BSCC; and

WHEREAS, BSCC requires a resolution from the City and County's governing board specifically delegating authority to the individual authorized to execute the grant agreement; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to participate in the LEAD grant program administered by the BSCC; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors to sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.
