

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 **APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO**  
3 **REPLACE THE HYDRAULICALLY INADEQUATE SEWERS ON 3<sup>RD</sup> STREET BETWEEN**  
4 **JERROLD AVENUE AND PALOU AVENUE, DONNER AVENUE BETWEEN INGALLS**  
5 **STREET AND JENNINGS STREET, AND JENNINGS STREET BETWEEN DONNER**  
6 **AVENUE AND EGBERT AVENUE.**

7 **WHEREAS**, On August 25, 1998, the Hydraulic Engineering Section of the Bureau of  
8 Engineering was requested by PUC Sewer Operations to replace the hydraulically inadequate sewers  
9 on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between Jerrold Avenue and Palou Avenue, Donner Avenue between Ingalls Street and  
10 Jennings Street, and Jennings Street between Donner Avenue and Egbert Avenue; and

11 **WHEREAS**, The existing sewers cause flooding during the storm season, and immediate  
12 replacement was required in order to protect the health, welfare, and property of Citizens of San  
13 Francisco; and

14 **WHEREAS**, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract  
15 No. CW-202E, "3<sup>rd</sup> Street Sewer System Improvements, Phase I Emergency" to replace the existing  
16 sewers with 1,244 linear feet of 33-inch, 308 linear feet of 36-inch, and 1,188 linear feet of 42-inch  
17 diameter reinforced concrete pipe (RCP), 26 linear feet of 18-inch, 25 linear feet of 21-inch and 27  
18 linear feet of 24-inch diameter vitrified clay pipe (VCP) encased in reinforced concrete on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street  
19 between Jerrold Avenue and Palou Avenue, Donner Avenue between Ingalls Street and Jennings  
20 Street, and Jennings Street between Donner Avenue and Egbert Avenue; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Construction began on September 4, 1998 and all work was specified to be  
22 completed on or before December 4, 1998. The Contractor actually completed the work on December  
23 2, 1998; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Because the size of this emergency contract, the HRC Contract Compliance Officer  
25 (CCO) established subcontracting goals of 22% for local MBEs and 8% for local WBEs, and

1           **WHEREAS**, The CCO has determined that the Contractor, McNamara & Smallman  
2 Construction Inc., made good faith efforts to achieve their MBE/WBE subcontracting goals. Therefore,  
3 their actual MBE/WBE subcontracting participation has been approved by the CCO; and

4           **WHEREAS**, The cost of the project is \$1,674,713.00, of which \$1,482,563.00 is for the  
5 construction contract. Funds are available from the 1988 Unrestricted Sewer Revenue Bonds  
6 (Fund5C/CPF/88B, FAMIS Project No. CENMSCF503, Job Order No. 1622N; and

7           **WHEREAS**, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section  
8 6.30 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an  
9 emergency; now, therefore, be it

10           **RESOLVED**, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the  
11 emergency work to replace the hydraulically inadequate sewers on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between Jerrold Avenue  
12 and Palou Avenue, Donner Avenue between Ingalls Street and Jennings Street, and Jennings Street  
13 between Donner Avenue and Egbert Avenue.
