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APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO REPLACE THE HYDRAULICALLY INADEQUATE SEWERS ON 3^{RD} STREET BETWEEN JERROLD AVENUE AND PALOU AVENUE, DONNER AVENUE BETWEEN INGALLS STREET AND JENNINGS STREET, AND JENNINGS STREET BETWEEN DONNER AVENUE AND EGBERT AVENUE.

WHEREAS, On August 25, 1998, the Hydraulic Engineering Section of the Bureau of Engineering was requested by PUC Sewer Operations to replace the hydraulically inadequate sewers on 3rd Street between Jerrold Avenue and Palou Avenue, Donner Avenue between Ingalls Street and Jennings Street, and Jennings Street between Donner Avenue and Egbert Avenue; and

WHEREAS, The existing sewers cause flooding during the storm season, and immediate replacement was required in order to protect the health, welfare, and property of Citizens of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract No. CW-202E, "3rd Street Sewer System Improvements, Phase I Emergency" to replace the existing sewers with 1,244 linear feet of 33-inch, 308 linear feet of 36-inch, and 1,188 linear feet of 42-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe (RCP), 26 linear feet of 18-inch, 25 linear feet of 21-inch and 27 linear feet of 24-inch diameter vitrified clay pipe (VCP) encased in reinforced concrete on 3rd Street between Jerrold Avenue and Palou Avenue, Donner Avenue between Ingalls Street and Jennings Street, and Jennings Street between Donner Avenue and Egbert Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Construction began on September 4, 1998 and all work was specified to be completed on or before December 4, 1998. The Contractor actually completed the work on December 2, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Because the size of this emergency contract, the HRC Contract Compliance Officer (CCO) established subcontracting goals of 22% for local MBEs and 8% for local WBEs, and

WHEREAS, The CCO has determined that the Contractor, McNamara & Smallman Construction Inc., made good faith efforts to achieve their MBE/WBE subcontracting goals. Therefore, their actual MBE/WBE subcontracting participation has been approved by the CCO; and

WHEREAS, The cost of the project is \$1,674,713.00, of which \$1,482,563.00 is for the construction contract. Funds are available from the 1988 Unrestricted Sewer Revenue Bonds (Fund5C/CPF/88B, FAMIS Project No. CENMSCF503, Job Order No. 1622N; and

WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an emergency; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the emergency work to replace the hydraulically inadequate sewers on 3rd Street between Jerrold Avenue and Palou Avenue, Donner Avenue between Ingalls Street and Jennings Street, and Jennings Street between Donner Avenue and Egbert Avenue.
