[Supporting Republic Services Workers at the San Francisco Bay Railway to Unionize]

Resolution supporting the rights of Republic Services workers at the San Francisco Bay Railway to unionize and negotiate a fair contract.

WHEREAS, Republic Services workers at the San Francisco Bay Railway (SFBR) have been trying to organize a union with the Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employees Division (BMWED - Teamsters Rail Conference); and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Bay Railway property is leased by Republic Services from the Port of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Republic Services is operating well below the Area Standard for wages and healthcare benefits; and

WHEREAS, For example, for family healthcare coverage, workers are required to pay over \$900 per month in premiums plus high deductibles and out-of-pocket maximums; and

WHEREAS, The SFBR workers have requested that Republic Services join them in a fair and free union recognition process known as "Card Check Neutrality" – a process that has been roundly rejected by management in preference for a delay-ridden election process overseen by the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, The actions of the workers to unionize are protected by federal law; and WHEREAS, San Francisco is a Union Town and the San Francisco Board of Supervisors has a history on record supporting the rights of workers to freely join under the protections of Collective Bargaining; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors strongly urges Republic Services to rapidly and without coercion engage its San Francisco Bay Railway workforce in a free and fair union recognition process; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors applauds the courage and persistence of the San Francisco Bay Railway workers in their struggle to organize a union at their workplace.
