7 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
8 hereby appoint the following designated person to serve as a member of the In-Home
9 Supportive Services Public Authority, pursuant to the provisions of California Welfare and
10 Institutions Code, Section 12301.6, and San Francisco Administrative Code, Chapter 70, for
11 the term specified:

12 Sascha Bittner, seat 11, succeeding Jessie Sandoval, resigned, must be a consumer
13 between the ages of 18 and 60, authorized to represent organizations that advocate for
14 younger people with disabilities, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending March
15 1, 2021;

16 Alexander Madrid, seat 9, succeeding Jim Blacksten, resigned, must be a member of the
17 Mayor's Disability Council, recommended to the Board by the Council, for the unexpired
18 portion of a three-year term ending March 1, 2022;

19 Daisy McArthur, seat 12, succeeding themselves, term expired, must be a member
20 representing the bargaining unit of the union that represents In-Home Supportive Services
21 independent providers, for a three-year term ending March 1, 2023;

22 Robin Wilson-Beattle, seat 13, succeeding Luis Calderon, term expired, must be a
23 consumer between the ages of 18 and 60, authorized to represent organizations that
24 advocate for younger people with disabilities, for a three-year term ending March 1, 2023.
