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9	WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant in the amount of

11	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, HRSA requires the City to		
12	enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the		
13	Board of Supervisors in File No; which is hereby declared to be a part of		
14	this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
15	WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds		
16	may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually		
17	considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure		
18	of grant funding; and,		
19	WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,		
20	therefore, be it		
21	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend a		
22	grant in the amount of \$110,343 from HRSA; and, be it		
23	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
24	indirect costs in the grant budget, and, be it		
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1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and		
2	expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement,		
3	pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it		
4	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
5	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
7	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when		
8	the agreement expires.
