**Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license to Eiming Jung, for 111 Minna Street Gallery located at 111 Minna Street (District 6), to include the increased area and additional bar constructed by the licensee as part of Minna Gallery’s expansion project, will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code; with conditions.**

WHEREAS, Eiming Jung is seeking issuance of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license for 111 Minna Street Gallery, located at 111 Minna Street (District 6), to include the increased area and additional bar constructed by the licensee as part of Minna Gallery’s expansion project; and,

WHEREAS, The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned; and recommends approval; and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license for 111 Minna Street Gallery, located at 111 Minna Street (District 6), to include the increased area and additional bar constructed by the licensee as part of Minna Gallery’s expansion project; will serve the

1 public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San  
2 Francisco.

3           Conditions: (1) Sales and service of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only  
4 between the hours of 12 noon and 2:00 a.m. each day of the week; (2) The petitioner(s)  
5 shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area in front of and adjacent to the  
6 premises over which they have control; (3) The petitioner(s) shall police the area under  
7 their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons about the premises; (4)  
8 Entertainment provided shall not be audible beyond the area under control of the  
9 licensee.




