9 WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco desires
10 to participate in a program designated "Boating Safety and Enforcement Vessel
11 Replacement Grant" funded from funds made available through the California
12 Department of Boating and Waterways to provide financial aid for law enforcement
13 agencies having a boating and safety unit; and

15 WHEREAS, the California Department of Boating and Waterways has offered the
16 San Francisco Police Department a grant to be used exclusively for it's Marine Unit; and


17 WHEREAS, benefits provided through this State Program will enable the Police
18 Department to more effectively enforce laws and promote boating safety; now therefore
19 be it



21 RESOLVED; that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is
22 authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to apply for retroactively,
23 accept and expend funding for this program from the California Department of Boating
24 and Waterways, and waiving indirect costs due to funding constraints; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San
2 Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the
3 necessary Grant Award Agreement for this program including any extensions, funding
4 augmentations from the California Department of Boating and Waterways, or
5 amendments thereof; and be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the
8 performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages,
9 shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency. The State of
10 California and the Department of Boating and Waterways disclaim responsibility for and
11 such liability; and be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
14 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.




