WHEREAS, A Consolidated General Election is scheduled to be held in the City and County of San Francisco on November 2, 2004 for the purpose of voting on candidates for federal, state and local office and proposed state and local ballot measures to be submitted to the voters; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors may call for one or more special elections to be held in the City and County of San Francisco on November 2, 2004 for the purpose of voting on proposed municipal bond measures, and consolidate any such elections with the Consolidated General Election scheduled for the same date; and

WHEREAS, The BART District Board of Directors called a district election to be held in the City and County of San Francisco on November 2, 2004 for the Director's seat in districts 7 and 9; and

WHEREAS, The BART District Board of Directors adopted Resolution Numbers 4907 and 4652 requesting consolidation of the BART district election on November 2, 2004 with the Consolidated General Election scheduled for the same date, and setting fees for candidate statements for the BART Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, The BART Board of Directors filed Resolutions 4907 and 4652 with the City and County of San Francisco on or before June 29, 2004; and,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the voting precincts, polling places, and officers of the BART elections shall, in every case, be the same; that there shall be only one set of election officers in each precinct, to wit, the election officers to be appointed by the Director of Elections for each precinct; that all candidates, ballot measures and bond proposals shall be set forth on the ballots provided for said election; that the elections shall be held in all respects as though there were only one election, and that all returns shall be canvassed by the Director of Elections as provided in the California Elections Code.
