# Accept and Expend Resolution

\$5.6 million FY21-22 Budget Act Grant Funds will support **capital expenses** related to the **Bayview Vehicle Triage Center** that opened in January 2022.

## Resolution authorizes HSH to:

- Execute a **standard agreement** with HCD.
- Retroactively accept and expend **\$5.6 m** FY21-22 Budget Act Grant Funds.

# Grant Budget Overview

FY21-22 Budget Act Grant: \$5.6 million

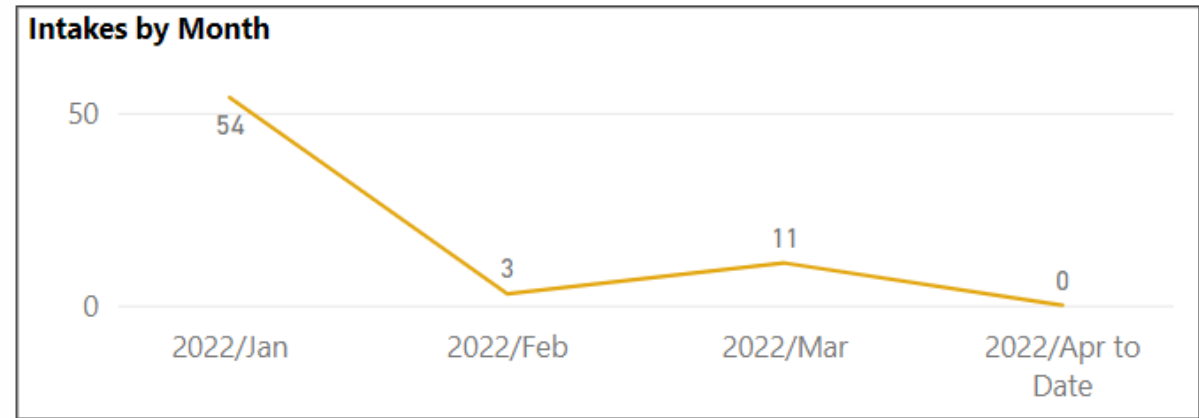
- \$4,200,000 for capital construction
- \$1,400,000 for professional services

# Impact of Bayview Vehicle Triage Center

The **Bayview Vehicle Triage Center** (VTC) opened in January 2022 with an initial capacity of 49 vehicles.



- As of April 12, 2022 the occupancy is **62 adults in 49 vehicles**.
- All clients are from the **Bayview**, with the majority from the Carroll Emergency Vehicle Site.
- Served a total of **68 households** since January 2022.
