22 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

23 Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in  
 24 this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public  
 25 Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the

1 Board of Supervisors in File No. 260131 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board  
2 affirms this determination.

4 Section 2. Chapter 94D of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising  
5 Section 94D.3, to read as follows:

6 **SEC. 94D.3. ELIGIBLE ACTIVATION LOCATIONS.**

7 Downtown Activation Locations are limited to the following:

8 \* \* \* \*

9 (f) "Jessie Alleys" located on Jessie Street between Fifth Street and Jessie Street West  
10 and between Fourth Street and Jesse Street East; Jessie Street West between Jessie Street and Mission  
11 Street; between Mission Street and Fifth Street ("Jessie West"); Jessie Street East between Jessie Street  
12 and Mission Street; and the northern side of Mission Street between Jessie Street East and Jessie Street  
13 West, excluding the public street portion of Mission Street and on Jessie Street and Jessie East between  
14 Mission Street and Fourth Street ("Jessie East");

15 \* \* \* \*

16 (i) "Minna Alley" located on Minna Street between ~~Second Street~~ Shaw Alley and New  
17 Montgomery Street;

18 (j) "Natoma" located on Natoma Street between ~~Second Street~~ New Montgomery Street  
19 and 180 feet northeast of Second Street ~~the southwestern corner of the Salesforce Transit Center~~  
20 ~~property; and~~

21 (k) "Second Street" located on Second Street between Market Street and Howard  
22 Street and Jessie Street between Second Street and New Montgomery Street; and

23 (l) "Yerba Buena Lane" located on Yerba Buena Lane, between Market Street and  
24 Mission Street; the southern side of Market Street between Yerba Buena Lane and 250 feet northeast  
25 of Yerba Buena Lane, excluding the public street portion of Market Street; and on the northern side of

1 Mission Street ~~only, excluding the public street portion of Mission Street~~, between Yerba Buena Lane  
2 and 3rd Street, and extending to and including Jessie Square, excluding the public street portion of  
3 Mission Street.

4  
5 Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors  
6 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,  
7 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal  
8 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment  
9 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the “Note” that appears under  
10 the official title of the ordinance.

11  
12 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective at 12:00 a.m. on the  
13 31st day after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor  
14 returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it,  
15 or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor’s veto of the ordinance.

## LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Downtown Activation Locations]

**Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to modify the Jessie Alleys Downtown Activation Location to include the northern side of Mission Street, excluding the public street portion of Mission Street between Jessie Street East and Jessie Street West, and to make clarifying revisions; the Minna Alley Downtown Activation Location to include Minna Street between Shaw Alley and New Montgomery Street; the Natoma Downtown Activation Location to include Natoma Street between New Montgomery Street and 180 feet northeast of Second Street; the Second Street Downtown Activation Location to include Jessie Street between Second Street and New Montgomery Street; and the Yerba Buena Lane Downtown Activation Location to include the southern side of Market Street between Yerba Buena Lane and 250 feet northeast of Yerba Buena Lane, excluding the public street portion of Market Street; and affirming the Planning Department’s determination under the California Environmental Quality Act.**

### Existing Law

Under Administrative Code Chapter 94D, the Greater Downtown Activation Program allows a Greater Downtown Community Benefit District to apply to Public Works for a Downtown Activation Permit for street activations that may include Entertainment Zones. Under Administrative Code Section 94D.3, such permits are available in Downtown Activation Locations.

Under Administrative Code Chapter 94B, open alcoholic beverages can be consumed on any public street, avenue, sidewalk, stairway, alley, or thoroughfare within an Entertainment Zone during an Entertainment Zone Event, subject to state and local law, when those beverages are purchased from a licensed premises within the Entertainment Zone.

Administrative Code Section 94B.1 defines an Entertainment Zone Event as “a special event permitted or licensed by ABC that occurs within the boundaries of an Entertainment Zone established in accordance with this Chapter 94B and within the hours permitted by this Chapter 94B and the Management Plan or the Downtown Activation Permit issued pursuant to Administrative Code Chapter 94D for the Entertainment Zone.”

### Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would modify the Jessie Alleys Downtown Activation Location to include the northern side of Mission Street, excluding the public street portion of Mission Street between Jessie Street East and Jessie Street West, and to make clarifying revisions; the Minna Alley Downtown Activation Location to include Minna Street between Shaw Alley and New

Montgomery Street; the Natoma Downtown Activation Location to include Natoma Street between New Montgomery Street and 180 feet northeast of Second Street; the Second Street Downtown Activation Location to include Jessie Street between Second Street and New Montgomery Street; and the Yerba Buena Lane Downtown Activation Location to include the southern side of Market Street between Yerba Buena Lane and 250 feet northeast of Yerba Buena Lane, excluding the public street portion of Market Street.


