[Waiver Allowing City Employees to Work on Election Day]

Motion granting a waiver from the prohibition imposed by Charter section 13.104.5, to permit employees of the Controller's Office and the City Attorney's Office and civil servants working for City departments, other than departments whose elective officer is standing for election on November 5, 2002, to serve as Field Election Deputies and otherwise assist the Department of Elections on November 5, 2002.

WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter section 13.104.5 prohibits City employees and officers (other than the Director of Elections, an appointee of the Director of Elections or a member of the Elections Commission) from performing "any function relating to the conduct of an election;" and

WHEREAS, Charter section 13.104.5 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, upon the request of the Elections Commission, to waive this prohibition for election day activity; and WHEREAS, The Elections Commission has requested that the Board of Supervisors

waive this prohibition to permit City employees to serve as Field Election Deputies and otherwise assist the Department of Elections on election day, November 5, 2002; now,

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the prohibition imposed by Charter section 13.104.5, to permit employees of the Controller's Office and the City Attorney's Office and civil servants working for City departments, other than departments whose elective officer is standing for election on November 5, 2002, to serve as Field Election Deputies and otherwise assist the Department of Elections on November 5, 2002.
