7	WHEREAS, The California Transportation Commission is authorized to make Traffic		
8	Congestion Relief Program funds available pursuant to the Traffic Congestion Relief Act of		
9	2000; and,		
10	WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency, City and County of San Francisco,		
11	is an eligible claimant for assistance pursuant to the Traffic Congestion Relief Program; and,		
12	WHEREAS, The Traffic Congestion Relief Program provides for \$540,000 of capital		
13	assistance to the Municipal Transportation Agency for the purpose of rehabilitating the		
14	Municipal Railway's Geneva Office Building; and,		
15	WHEREAS, These funds were allocated to the Bay Area Rapid Transit District as part		
16	of the Bay Area Rapid Transit District's Balboa Park Station Improvement Project; and,		
17	WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency must execute an agreement with the		
18	Bay Area Rapid Transit district to transfer the funds to the Municipal Transportation Agency;		
19	and,		
20	WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency proposes to maximize use of		
21	available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant		
22	budget; now, therefore, be it		
23	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Municipal Transportation		
24	Agency to accept and expend \$540,000 of Traffic Congestion Relief Program (TCRP) funds		
25	from the California Transportation Commission through the Bay Area Rapid Transit District for		

1	the purpose of rehabilitating the San Francisco Municipal Railway's Geneva Office Building;		
2	and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
4	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it		
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Municipal Transportation Agency and its Director are		
6	authorized to execute an agreement with the Bay Area Rapid Transit District to transfer these		
7	TCRP funds to the Municipal Transportation Agency and furnish whatever additional		
8	information as might be requested by the funding agencies and the Bay Area Rapid Transit		
9	District in connection with this request.
