4 **Forever Stamp, in honor and in memory of Matthew Shepard.**

6 WHEREAS, Matthew Shepard was born on December 1, 1976 in Casper, Wyoming  
7 and grew into a young man passionate about equality and human rights; and

8 WHEREAS, His tragic murder in 1998, one of the most notorious anti-gay hate crimes  
9 in our nation’s history, became the catalyst for significant shift in public awareness and policy,  
10 leading to the enactment of the Matthew Shepard and James Byrd, Jr. Hate Crimes

11 Prevention Act, a landmark piece of legislation that provides federal protections for violent  
12 acts based on actual or perceived gender, disability, sexual orientation, or gender identify; and

13 WHEREAS, Issuing a commemorative stamp in Matthew Shepard’s honor would  
14 memorialize his life and legacy and also serve as a reminder of our ongoing responsibility to  
15 champion the values of acceptance and equality; and

16 WHEREAS, Such a stamp would symbolically represent our collective stand against  
17 hate in all forms and our commitment to building a more inclusive and compassionate society;

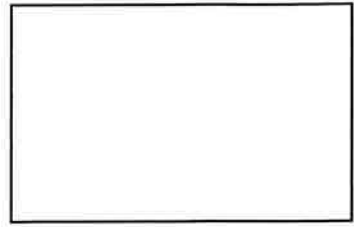
19 WHEREAS, In light of the profound influence of Matthew Shepard’s life and death on  
20 our nation’s journey toward greater acceptance and equality, it is fitting and proper that we
