RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF CERTIFICATES OF PARTICIPATION BY THE CALIFORNIA STATEWIDE COMMUNTIES DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY IN AN AGGREGATE PRINICPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$110,000,000 FOR SUTTER HEALTH AND CALIFORNIA PACIFIC MEDICAL CENTER.

WHEREAS, The California Statewide Communities Development Authority, a joint exercise of powers agency established pursuant to the laws of the State of California ("CSCDA") has proposed to execute and deliver certificates of participation in an aggregate principal amount not expected to exceed \$110,000,000, each representing a proportionate undivided interest in installment payments pursuant to a purchase agreement (the "Issue") between CSCDA and Sutter Health and California Pacific Medical Center and certain other affiliates of Sutter Health; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco (the "City") is a member of CSCDA; and.

WHEREAS. The project to be refinanced by the Issue consists of the acquisition. improvement and equipping of certain health facilities owned or operated by California Pacific Medical Center located in the City (the "Project"); and,

WHEREAS, The interest on the Issue may qualify for tax exemption under Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") only if the Issue is approved in accordance with Section 147(f) of the Code; and,

WHEREAS, CSCDA has requested that the Board of Supervisors of the City (the "Board") approve the Issue in order to satisfy the public approval requirements of Section 147(f) of the Code and the requirements of Section 9 of the Amended and Restated Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement (the "Agreement"), dated as of June 1, 1988, among certain local agencies, including the City; and,

SUPERVISOR BARBARA KAUFMAN **BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

WHEREAS, CSCDA has reviewed the financial structure of the Issue and has heretofore approved the Issue; and,

WHEREAS, The Project is located wholly within the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, On August 25,1999, the City caused a notice stating that a public hearing with respect to the issuance of the Issue would be held by the Mayor's Office of Public Finance on September 9, 1999, to appear in *The San Francisco Daily Journal*, which is a newspaper of general circulation in the City; and,

WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office has held the public hearing described above on September 9, 1999, and an opportunity was provided for persons to comment on the Issue and the Project; and,

WHEREAS, The Board is the elected legislative body of the City and is the applicable elected representative required to approve the Issue within the meaning of Section 147(f) of the Code and Section 9 of the Agreement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board hereby finds and declares the above recitals are true and correct; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Board hereby approves the Issue by CSCDA. It is the purpose and intent of this Board that this Resolution constitute approval of the Issue by the applicable elected representative of the governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which the Project is located, in accordance with Section 147(f) of the Code; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the approval of this Board of the Issue by CSCDA is neither an approval of the underlying credit issues of the proposed Project nor an approval of the financial structure of the Issue.
