URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO CHRONICLE AND EXAMINER TO DONATE JOINT

REVENUES FROM PUBLICATION OF THE ADVERTISEMENT PROMOTING A CURE FOR HOMOSEXUALITY TO THE GAY LESBIAN ALLIANCE AGAINST DEFAMATION.

WHEREAS, The current national dialogue about homosexuality has become increasingly homophobic, fueled by right-wing rhetoric that homosexuality is sinful; and

WHEREAS, Several right-wing Christian organizations have begun a national ad campaign proclaiming that homosexuality can be "cured" and suggesting that sexually-transmitted diseases are a punishment from God; and

WHEREAS, Locally, the Gay Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation has spearheaded efforts to combat hate crimes and intolerance that are often spurred by such rhetoric; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Examiner chose to publish an advertisement promoting a cure for homosexuality despite recent statistics demonstrating a local increase in anti-gay violence; and

WHEREAS, Sound advertising policy requires an exercise of judgment: free speech does not justify publishing – for profit – inflammatory views that are racist, sexist, homophobic, or otherwise offensive to a segment of the population; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the joint advertising agency of the San Francisco Chronicle and the San Francisco Examiner to donate revenues from publication of the advertisement promoting a cure for homosexuality to the Gay Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation.
