[Making Environmental Findings and Re-Authorizing Vehicle Registration Fee.]

Resolution making environmental findings and re-authorizing a one dollar (\$1) fee to be paid at time of vehicle registration, renewal, or supplemental application for every vehicle registered to an address within the City and County of San Francisco, except exempt vehicles, to be used exclusively to fund law enforcement programs related to fingerprint identification of persons committing crimes while operating motor vehicles; Ratifying said fees paid between January 1, 2003, and the effective date of this resolution; And authorizing the Police Department to issue a fiscal yearend report to the California State Controller on the collection and use of these fees.

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this Resolution are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. <u>030521</u> and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 authorizes, upon adoption of a resolution of the Board of Supervisors, a fee of one dollar (\$1) shall be paid at the time of registration, renewal, or supplemental application for apportioned registration pursuant to Article 4 (commencing with Section 8050) of Chapter 4 of the California Vehicle Code of every vehicle, except vehicles described in subdivision (a) of Section 5014.1, registered to an address within the City and County of San Francisco, except those expressly exempted from payment of registration fees; and,

WHEREAS, funds allocated pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 shall be expended exclusively to enhance the capacity of local law enforcement to provide automated mobile and fixed location fingerprint identification of individuals who may be

MAYOR BOARD OF SUPERVISORS involved in driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs in violation of Section 23152 and 23153, or vehicular manslaughter in violation of Section 191.5 of the Penal Code or subdivision (c) of Section 192 of the Penal Code, or any combination of those and other vehicle-related crimes, and other crimes committed while operating a motor vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Police Department operates an automated mobile and fixed fingerprint identification system to aid in the identification of individuals who may be involved in driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs in violation of Section 23152 and 23153, or vehicular manslaughter in violation of Section 191.5 of the Penal Code or subdivision (c) of Section 192 of the Penal Code, or any combination of those and other vehicle-related crimes, and other crimes committed while operating a motor vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Police Department desires to continue to receive funds under California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 to be expended for the maintenance, enhancement, and expansion of the automated mobile and fixed fingerprint identification system; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That a fee of one dollar (\$1) shall be paid at the time of registration, renewal, or supplemental application for apportioned registration pursuant to Article 4 (commencing with Section 8050) of Chapter 4 of the California Vehicle Code of every vehicle, except vehicles described in subdivision (a) of Section 5014.1, registered to an address within the City and County of San Francisco, except those expressly exempted from payment of registration fees; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Police Department is requested and authorized to consult with the Controller of the City and County of San Francisco and to issue a fiscal yearend report to the California State Controller on or before November 1 of each year, summarizing, with respect to fees collected pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section

MAYOR BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 92501.9: (1) the total revenue that the City and County of San Francisco received; (2) the total expenditures and encumbered funds by the City and County of San Francisco; (3) any unexpended or unencumbered fee revenues for the City and County of San Francisco; (4) the estimated annual costs of the purchase, operation, and maintenance of automated mobile and fixed location fingerprint equipment, related infrastructure, law enforcement enhancement programs, and personnel created or utilized by the City and County of San Francisco; and (5) how the use of the funds benefited the motoring public; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this fee shall be in effect from January 1, 2003, until January 1, 2006, unless a later enacted statute deletes or extends this date; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the fee of one dollar (\$1) paid at the time of registration, renewal, or supplemental application for apportioned registration pursuant to Article 4 (commencing with Section 8050) of Chapter 4 of the California Vehicle Code of every vehicle, except vehicles described in subdivision (a) of Section 5014.1, registered to an address within the City and County of San Francisco, except those expressly exempted from payment of registration fees, collected from January 1, 2003, until the effective date of this resolution are hereby ratified.
