

1 [Making Environmental Findings and Re-Authorizing Vehicle Registration Fee.]

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3 **Resolution making environmental findings and re-authorizing a one dollar (\$1) fee to be**  
4 **paid at time of vehicle registration, renewal, or supplemental application for every**  
5 **vehicle registered to an address within the City and County of San Francisco, except**  
6 **exempt vehicles, to be used exclusively to fund law enforcement programs related to**  
7 **fingerprint identification of persons committing crimes while operating motor vehicles;**  
8 **Ratifying said fees paid between January 1, 2003, and the effective date of this**  
9 **resolution; And authorizing the Police Department to issue a fiscal yearend report to**  
10 **the California State Controller on the collection and use of these fees.**

12 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in  
13 this Resolution are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California  
14 Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the  
15 Board in File No. 030521 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

16 WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 authorizes, upon adoption of a  
17 resolution of the Board of Supervisors, a fee of one dollar (\$1) shall be paid at the time of  
18 registration, renewal, or supplemental application for apportioned registration pursuant to  
19 Article 4 (commencing with Section 8050) of Chapter 4 of the California Vehicle Code of every  
20 vehicle, except vehicles described in subdivision (a) of Section 5014.1, registered to an  
21 address within the City and County of San Francisco, except those expressly exempted from  
22 payment of registration fees; and,

23 WHEREAS, funds allocated pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 shall  
24 be expended exclusively to enhance the capacity of local law enforcement to provide  
25 automated mobile and fixed location fingerprint identification of individuals who may be

1 involved in driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs in violation of Section 23152 and  
2 23153, or vehicular manslaughter in violation of Section 191.5 of the Penal Code or  
3 subdivision (c) of Section 192 of the Penal Code, or any combination of those and other  
4 vehicle-related crimes, and other crimes committed while operating a motor vehicle;  
5 and,

6 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Police Department operates an automated mobile and  
7 fixed fingerprint identification system to aid in the identification of individuals who may be  
8 involved in driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs in violation of Section 23152 and  
9 23153, or vehicular manslaughter in violation of Section 191.5 of the Penal Code or  
10 subdivision (c) of Section 192 of the Penal Code, or any combination of those and other  
11 vehicle-related crimes, and other crimes committed while operating a motor vehicle; and,

12 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Police Department desires to continue to receive funds  
13 under California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 to be expended for the maintenance,  
14 enhancement, and expansion of the automated mobile and fixed fingerprint identification  
15 system; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That a fee of one dollar (\$1) shall be paid at the time of registration,  
17 renewal, or supplemental application for apportioned registration pursuant to Article 4  
18 (commencing with Section 8050) of Chapter 4 of the California Vehicle Code of every vehicle,  
19 except vehicles described in subdivision (a) of Section 5014.1, registered to an address within  
20 the City and County of San Francisco, except those expressly exempted from payment of  
21 registration fees; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Police Department is requested and  
23 authorized to consult with the Controller of the City and County of San Francisco and to issue  
24 a fiscal yearend report to the California State Controller on or before November 1 of each  
25 year, summarizing, with respect to fees collected pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section

1 92501.9: (1) the total revenue that the City and County of San Francisco received; (2) the total  
2 expenditures and encumbered funds by the City and County of San Francisco; (3) any  
3 unexpended or unencumbered fee revenues for the City and County of San Francisco; (4) the  
4 estimated annual costs of the purchase, operation, and maintenance of automated mobile and  
5 fixed location fingerprint equipment, related infrastructure, law enforcement enhancement  
6 programs, and personnel created or utilized by the City and County of San Francisco; and (5)  
7 how the use of the funds benefited the motoring public; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That this fee shall be in effect from January 1, 2003, until  
9 January 1, 2006, unless a later enacted statute deletes or extends this date; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the fee of one dollar (\$1) paid at the time of registration,  
11 renewal, or supplemental application for apportioned registration pursuant to Article 4  
12 (commencing with Section 8050) of Chapter 4 of the California Vehicle Code of every vehicle,  
13 except vehicles described in subdivision (a) of Section 5014.1, registered to an address within  
14 the City and County of San Francisco, except those expressly exempted from payment of  
15 registration fees, collected from January 1, 2003, until the effective date of this resolution are  
16 hereby ratified.

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
