

7 8	WHEREAS, The Development, Relief, and Education for Alien Minors (DREAM) Act is bipartisan legislation that addresses the situation faced by young people who were brought to
9	the United States years ago as undocumented immigrant children and who have since grown
10	up here, stayed in school, and kept out of trouble; and,
11	WHEREAS, Each year 65,000 United States-raised students who qualify for the
12	DREAM Act's benefits graduate from high school; and,
13	WHEREAS, On April 21, 2010, Assistant Senate Majority Leader Dick Durbin (D-IL)
14	and Senator Richard Lugar (R-IN), asked the U.S. Department of Homeland Security
15	Secretary Janet Napolitano, to halt the deportation of immigrant students who could earn
16	legal status under the DREAM Act; and,
17	WHEREAS, The DREAM Act has the support of the House and Senate leadership, all
18	of the relevant committees chairs, as well as our nation's military leaders including the former
19	secretary of state, General Colin Powell; and,
20	WHEREAS, On September 15, 2010, President Barack Obama, before the
21	Congressional Hispanic Caucus, expressed his full support of the DREAM Act stating, "I will
22	do whatever it takes to support the efforts to pass this bill so that I can sign it into law on
23	behalf of students seeking a college education and those who wish to serve in our country's

1	WHEREAS, Shing Ma "Steve" Litis a junior at City College of San Francisco and
2	aspires to be a health care worker serving communities in the Bay Area. He graduated from
3	George Washington High School where he was an editor and reporter for the school
4	newspaper, and was on the track and cross country team. He is scheduled to graduate from
5	City College in Spring 2011; and,
6	WHEREAS, Shing Ma "Steve" Li entered the United States with his family when he
7	was about 12 years old. He was ordered removed from the United States to Peru when he
8	was 14-years old. He had no knowledge of the deportation, because he was a derivative
9	beneficiary of his mother's political asylum application. When the Immigration Judge denied
10	his mother immigration status, the decision effectively denied him status in the United States
11	while he was a minor. He was never informed that he was a fugitive in the United States;
12	and,
13	WHEREAS, Shing Ma "Steve" Li was arrested along with his parents pursuant to an
14	Immigration and Customs Enforcement directive called the Fugitive Operations Program.
15	The Program was intended to target dangerous fugitive immigrants, but instead, it has swept
16	up young undocumented children who never knew they had been ordered removed. The
17	Fugitive Operations Program does not serve any national security purpose; and,
18	WHEREAS, Shing Ma "Steve" Li is DREAM Act eligible, and his deportation to Peru
19	should be halted; and,
20	WHEREAS, Immigration and Customs Enforcement should grant his application for
21	deferred action and allow him to remain in the United States; and,
22	WHERAS, Deporting DREAM Act children is unfair and a violation of their
23	constitutional rights. While the immigration system is broken, deporting immigrant children is
24	not the answer; and,

1	WHEREAS, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors recognizes the support of the
2	community at City College of San Francisco including his mentors, classmates and
3	professors, the Asian Law Caucus, Chinese for Affirmative Action, and the Asian Pacific
4	American community. In less than one week, the community has called, emailed, and written
5	over 500 letters to Senator Dianne Feinstein and Speaker Nancy Pelosi asking that they
6	speak out against the deportation of Shing Ma "Steve" Li: now, therefore, be it
7	RESOLVED, That unless the DREAM Act is passed by Congress, all deportation of
8 9	immigrant children should be stopped; and, be it RESOLVED, That unless the DREAM Act is passed, Shing Ma "Steve" Li should be
10	released from ICE custody, returned to his mother and family in San Francisco, and be
11 12	allowed to remain in the United States under the deferred action plan; and, be it  FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges that until  Congress passes the DREAM Act, and that Senator Feinstein or Senator Boxer issue a
13	private bill on behalf of Shing Ma "Steve" Li.
