

1 [Changing Official Width of Sidewalk]

3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled “Regulating the Width of**
4 **Sidewalks" by adding thereto Section 1556 to change the official sidewalk**
5 **width on a portion of 16th Street, 246.71 feet southwest of Potrero Avenue;**
6 **making findings pursuant to the General Plan and Planning Code Section**
7 **101.1; and requiring relocation, modification, or both of facilities affected**
8 **by the sidewalk width changes.**

9
10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates
12 by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning
13 Department in its letter dated May 23, 2002, which stated that the actions
14 contemplated herein are consistent with the General Plan and Eight Priority
15 Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of such letter is in the Clerk of
16 the Board of Supervisors File No. 021827.

17 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works’ Order No.
18 173,697, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No.
19 021827, Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled “Regulating the
20 Width of Sidewalks,” a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
21 Book of General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by
22 adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

23 Section 1556. The width of sidewalks on portion of 16th Street, 246.71
24 feet southwest of Portrero Avenue shall be modified as shown on Department of
25 Public Works drawing Q-20-547, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of
Supervisors File No. 021827.

1 Section 3. JC Decaux San Francisco, Inc., the project sponsor who
2 proposes to undertake the sidewalk construction to implement the sidewalk width
3 changes, is required to make arrangements with public utilities and City
4 Departments concerning relocation, modification, or both of facilities in the
5 affected sidewalk and street areas. Any necessary relocation, modification, or
6 both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and County of San Francisco.
