WHEREAS, MOCI desires to receive and utilize federal grant funds available through the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants (JABG) Program administered by the Corrections Standards Authority (CSA); and

WHEREAS, MOCI in partnership with DCYF/CRN's will leverage existing intensive case management of high-risk juvenile offenders in hotspot neighborhoods through securing JABG funds for greatly needed vehicles for safe transportation and highly structured youth leadership and team building retreats, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Director of MOCI is authorized on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco to submit the JABG application and sign the Grant Agreement with CSA, including any amendments thereof; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of San Francisco agrees to provide all matching funds required for said project, a 10% match will be provided by DCYF from existing CRN intensive case management funds; and abide by the statutes and regulations governing the JABG Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by CSA; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received will be encumbered by June 30, 2009 and liquidated by September 29, 2009, and no requests for extension will be submitted, and WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and, WHEREAS, The grant permits indirect costs at 5% of total grant costs, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco will include in the budget indirect costs at 5% of total grant costs.
