

1 [Waiver Permitting Employees of the Department of Administrative Services to Provide  
2 Information Technology Services to the Department of Elections on March 5, 2002.]

3 **Motion granting a waiver from the prohibition imposed by Charter section 13.104.5, to**  
4 **permit employees of the Department of Administrative Services to provide information**  
5 **technology services to the Department of Elections on March 5, 2002.**

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter section 13.104.5 prohibits City employees and  
8 officers (other than the Director of Elections, an appointee of the Director of Elections or a  
9 member of the Elections Commission) from performing “any function relating to the conduct of  
10 an election;” and,

11 WHEREAS, Charter section 13.104.5 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, upon the  
12 request of the Elections Commission, to waive this prohibition for election day activity; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Elections Commission has requested that the Board of Supervisors  
14 waive this prohibition to permit employees of the Department of Administrative Services to  
15 provide information technology services to the Department of Elections on election day, March  
16 5, 2002; and,

17 WHEREAS, These employees of the Department of Administrative Services would  
18 direct and coordinate the operation of vote tabulation equipment and the electronic reporting  
19 of results; now, therefore, be it

20 Moved, That the Board of Supervisors waives the prohibition imposed by Charter  
21 section 13.104.5, to permit employees of the Department of Administrative Services to provide  
22 these information technology services to the Department of Elections on March 5, 2002.
