

1 [Recreation and Park Department - Single Entrance Fee For Visitors To Enter Multiple  
2 Recreation & Park Sites]

4 **Ordinance amending San Francisco Park Code, Article 12, by adding Section 12.49 to:**  
5 **1) establish entrance fees for multiple park facilities; 2) require Commission approval**  
6 **of contracts and grants for the collection of fees; and making environmental findings.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. Findings.

12 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this  
13 Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public  
14 Resources Code section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the  
15 Board of Supervisors in File No. 101478 and is incorporated herein by reference.

16  
17 Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.49,  
18 to read as follows:

19 **SEC. 12.49. MULTIPLE SITE ENTRANCE FEES.**

20 (a) The Department shall charge the following fees for a one day pass, that will allow  
21 admission on one date, to all of the following facilities: Coit Tower, the Conservatory of Flowers, the  
22 Japanese Tea Garden and, for non-San Francisco residents, the Botanical Garden, with no additional  
23 charge:

	<u>S.F. Residents</u>	<u>Non-Residents</u>
<u>Adults</u>	<u>\$12</u>	<u>\$25</u>
<u>Seniors 65+</u>	<u>\$6</u>	<u>\$15</u>
<u>Youth (11-17 years)</u>	<u>\$6</u>	<u>\$15</u>
<u>Child (5-11 years)</u>	<u>\$3</u>	<u>\$6</u>

*b) All contracts, grant agreements or other types of agreements that authorize a non-City entity to collect entrance fees at a particular facility are subject to the approval of the Commission. Such agreements may: (1) authorize the Department to pay the contractor or grantee an administrative fee for collecting such fees not to exceed 12% of the amount collected, and (2) where the entity collecting the fee is a nonprofit entity that supports the facility, waive entrance fees to the particular facility for members of that entity.*
