3 **Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by adding Section 10.100-**  
4 **371 to establish the Department of Public Works Greening Fund as a Category Six**  
5 **Fund.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding  
11 Section 10.100-371, to read as follows:

12 **SEC. 10.100-371. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS GREENING FUND.**

13 **(a) Establishment of Fund.** *The Department of Public Works Greening Fund is hereby*  
14 *established as a category six fund for the purpose of receiving all cash gifts, donations and*  
15 *contributions of money that may from time to time be offered to the City and County to pay for*  
16 *Department of Public Works design, construction and/or maintenance of Greening Projects.*  
17 *“Greening Projects” shall mean projects designed to establish public landscaped areas, gardens and*  
18 *plazas in San Francisco's streets and public rights-of-way including, but not limited to, Pavement to*  
19 *Parks projects.*

20 **(b) Use of Fund.** *All monies deposited into the fund shall, consistent with the gift, donation, or*  
21 *contribution, be expended for implementation and/or maintenance of Greening Projects and*  
22 *improvements prescribed by the City’s Better Streets Plan to calm traffic, improve pedestrian and*  
23 *bicycle safety and to manage storm water runoff.*

24 **(c) Administration of Fund.** *The Director of the Department of Public Works is authorized to*  
25 *accept all gifts to the Department of Public Works for the uses and purposes described in subsection*

1 (b), including but not limited to gifts of money, equipment, property, supplies and services. Gifts to the  
2 fund are exempt from the provisions of Administrative Code Section 10.100-305.
