

1 [Appointment - Animal Control and Welfare Commission]

3 **Resolution appointing Gerald Yeager, William Hamilton, Sherri Franklin and Richard**
4 **Schulke, terms ending April 30, 2007, to the Animal Control and Welfare Commission,**
5 **residency requirement waived.**

7 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
8 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Animal
9 Control and Welfare Commission, pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco Health
10 Code, Section 41.1, for the term specified:

11 Gerald Yeager, succeeding Elissa Eckman, term expired, seat 3, must be a member
12 representing the general public having interest and experience in animal matters, for the
13 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 30, 2007.

14 William Hamilton (residency requirement waived), succeeding Chin Chi, term expired,
15 seat 4, must be a member representing the general public having interest and experience in
16 animal matters, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 30, 2007.

17 Sherri Franklin, succeeding herself, term expired, seat 5, must be a member
18 representing the general public having interest and experience in animal matters, for the
19 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 30, 2007.

20 Richard Schulke, succeeding Susan Kendall Wheeler, term expired, seat 6, must be a
21 member representing the general public having interest and experience in animal matters, for
22 the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 30, 2007; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 24 1. The membership of the Animal Control and Welfare Commission has a goal to be
25 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

- 1 2. Applicant William Hamilton, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San
2 Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on
3 the Animal Control and Welfare Commission.
- 4 3. The Animal Control and Welfare Commission has attempted to fill the position, for
5 which William Hamilton was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident
6 and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable
7 to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that William Hamilton is
8 qualified to serve on the Animal Control and Welfare Commission.
- 9 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
10 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the
11 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is
12 willing to serve on the Animal Control and Welfare Commission at this time; and, be
13 it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency
15 requirement for William Hamilton, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing
16 to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s)
17 appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the
18 Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
