7 students, and the general public in San Francisco, and the Sunset
8 District specifically; and,

9 WHEREAS, To the extent possible, swimming facilities should be
10 Olympic size for that they can be used for competitions; and,

11 WHEREAS, Sava Pool, located in Larsen Park, at 19th Avenue and
12 Vicente, currently has a pool that is 33 1/3 meters, which is not
13 Olympic size; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Sava Pool site presents the City with a prime
15 opportunity to expand upon the existing site to construct an Olympic
16 size swimming facility; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
18 of San Francisco urges the Recreation and Park Department to perform
19 a feasibility study of constructing a San Francisco Swim Center at
20 Larsen Park.
