

1 [Accept & Expend State grants for food and agricultural projects.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
4 **and expend retroactively three grants totaling \$11,855.40, from the California**
5 **Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA); for the period of July 1, 2009 through**
6 **June 30, 2010.**

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8 WHEREAS, DPH's Environmental Health Section was awarded three grants from the
9 CDFA, including Petroleum and Weighmaster project (\$8,250), Egg Inspections (\$2,465.40),
10 and Organic Foods (\$1,140) for a total of \$11,855.40 for the period of July 1, 2009 through
11 June 30, 2010; and

12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDFA requires the City to
13 comply with the terms of three separate agreements (the "Agreements"), copies of which are
14 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 091042_____, which is hereby
15 declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses
17 the Department for three existing positions: two Agricultural Inspectors (Job Class #3450) at
18 0.05 and 0.06 FTE and an Inspector of Weights and Measures (Job Class #6220) 0.05 FTE
19 for the period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and,

20 WHEREAS, The budget does not include a provision for indirect costs because CDFA
21 does not allow it; now therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively three
23 grant from the in the amount of \$11,855.40; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
25 indirect costs in the grant budgets; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
 2 funded under this agreement as “G” or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
 3 the agreement expires; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
 5 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
 6 be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
 8 agreement on behalf of the City.
