

1 [Resolution authorizing the Sheriff to execute contracts with the State]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Sheriff’s Department to execute contracts with the California**
4 **Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) for the care and confinement of**
5 **inmates/parolees while pending probable cause determination, revocation of parole or**
6 **being returned to custody.**

8 WHEREAS, the State of California is legally bound to conduct Probable Cause
9 hearings within 10 business days of the notice of charges for alleged violation of terms and
10 conditions of parole; and,

11 WHEREAS, the State of California is legally bound to conduct revocation hearings at
12 which parole agents present to the Board of Prison Hearings all known facts regarding a
13 parole violation, a description of a parolee’s conduct while on parole and a recommendation
14 appropriate to the case; and,

15 WHEREAS, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) seeks to
16 enter into a contract with the City and County of San Francisco for the care and confinement
17 of inmates/parolees while pending probable cause determination, revocation of parole or
18 being returned to custody; and,

19 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco Sheriff’s Department is the agency
20 charged with the care and confinement of arrested persons for the City and County of San
21 Francisco; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco County Sheriff, or his designee, is hereby
23 authorized to execute any contracts with the California Department of Corrections and
24 Rehabilitation for the purposes of care and confinement of inmates/parolees awaiting
25 probable cause determination, revocation of parole hearings, or being returned to custody.
