10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
11			
12	Section 1. General Findings.		
13	Under California law, a standard monetary penalty for misdemeanor offenses is		
14	\$1,000. The state law addressing sideshows and street takeovers, California Vehicle Code		
15	Section 23109, sets the maximum fine at \$1,000. Many other California cities and counties,		
16	including Oakland, Fresno, Santa Rosa, and Sonoma County, have set the fine for a violation		
17	of their local sideshow ordinance at an amount not to exceed \$1,000. It is in the public		
18	interest that San Francisco align the maximum monetary penalty for violations of its local		
19	sideshow ordinance with state law and Bay Area municipalities to reflect the seriousness of		
20	these offenses.		
21			
22	Section 2. Article 56 of the Police Code is hereby amended by revising Section 5608		
23	as follows:		
24	SEC. 5608. PENALTY.		
25	Any person who violates Sections 5603, 5604, 5605, or 5607 is guilty of a		

1	misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed
2	\$5001,000, or by imprisonment for a period of not to exceed six months, or by both such fine
3	and imprisonment.
4	
5	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
6	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
7	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
8	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
9	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
10	the official title of the ordinance.
11	
12	Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
13	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
14	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
15	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
