

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 **APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO**  
3 **REPLACE THE STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE BRICK SEWER ON POLK STREET**  
4 **FROM SUTTER STREET TO BUSH STREET.**

5 **WHEREAS**, On November 5, 1998, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency condition on  
6 Polk Street from Sutter Street to Bush Street; and

7 **WHEREAS**, The existing brick sewer had missing bricks in the crown and invert and voids  
8 throughout the sewer main, and immediate replacement was required in order to protect the health,  
9 welfare, and property of the Citizens of San Francisco; and

10 **WHEREAS**, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract  
11 No. CW-223E, "Polk Street Emergency Sewer Replacement" to replace the existing 3' x 5' brick main  
12 sewer on Polk Street from Sutter Street to Bush Street with approximately 332 linear feet of 36-inch and  
13 33 linear feet of 42-inch diameter RCP sewer and 36 linear feet of 12-inch diameter VCP sewer; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Because this was an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals were not  
15 established by the HRC Contract Compliance Officer assigned to monitor the Clean Water sewer  
16 replacement program; and

17 **WHEREAS**, The original contract as awarded to K.J. Woods Construction was for \$214,000.00  
18 and allowed 63 calendar days for completion of the work; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Change Order No. 1 for approximately \$46,000.00 is being prepared to allow a time  
20 extension of 31 calendar days to account for unforeseen conditions in the field; and

21 **WHEREAS**, The Contractor, K.J. Woods Construction, began the emergency work on November  
22 23, 1998 and completed it on February 24, 1999; and

23 **WHEREAS**, The cost of the project is estimated to be \$310,650.00, of which \$260,000.00 is for  
24 the construction contract. Funds are available from the Repair and Replacement Fund (Fund  
25 5C/CPF/R&R, FAMIS Project No. CENRNR001, Job Order No. 1773N); and

1           **WHEREAS**, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30  
2 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an  
3 emergency; now, therefore, be it

4           **RESOLVED**, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the  
5 emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer on Polk Street from Sutter Street to Bush  
6 Street.
