2 APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT OF THE UNLITIGATED CLAIM FILED BY SAN  
3 FRANCISCO AGAINST THE PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY ("PG&E") FOR \$1.1  
4 MILLION DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$1,100,000); ADDITIONAL MATERIAL TERMS OF  
5 SAID SETTLEMENT ARE THE PARTIES AGREE TO CONTINUE IN GOOD FAITH THEIR

8 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco has a claim against the Pacific Gas  
9 and Electric Company for damages; and

10 WHEREAS, The Office of the City Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco  
11 has recommended settlement of said claim by acceptance of \$1.1 Million Dollars and no  
12 Cents (\$1,100,000) and the parties agree to continue in good faith their discussions regarding  
13 corrective actions which may be appropriate to improve the reliability of PG&E'S electric  
14 service to San Francisco; and

15 WHEREAS, The City Attorney has approved the settlement; now, therefore, be it  
16 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.22 of the San Francisco Administrative Code,  
17 settlement and compromise of said claim by acceptance of \$1.1 Million Dollars and no Cents  
18 (\$1,100,000) is hereby approved.




