Summary

San Francisco Public Works requests authorization to accept and expend \$15,000,000 2018 Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) Transportation Discretionary Grant funds. Public Works will use awarded funding for the Better Market Street Phase 1 project.

Background

On April 27, 2018, the U.S. Office of the Secretary of Transportation released a Notice of Funding Opportunity for the FY 2018 Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development Transportation Discretionary Grant program funded under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2018.

On July 18, 2018, San Francisco Public Works submitted a 2018 BUILD grant application for Better Market Street Phase 1. In December 2018, the U.S. Department of Transportation awarded \$15,000,000 to the Better Market Street Phase 1 project for construction phase expenditures. Projects funded from the FY 2018 BUILD Transportation Discretionary Grant program require a 20% local match.
