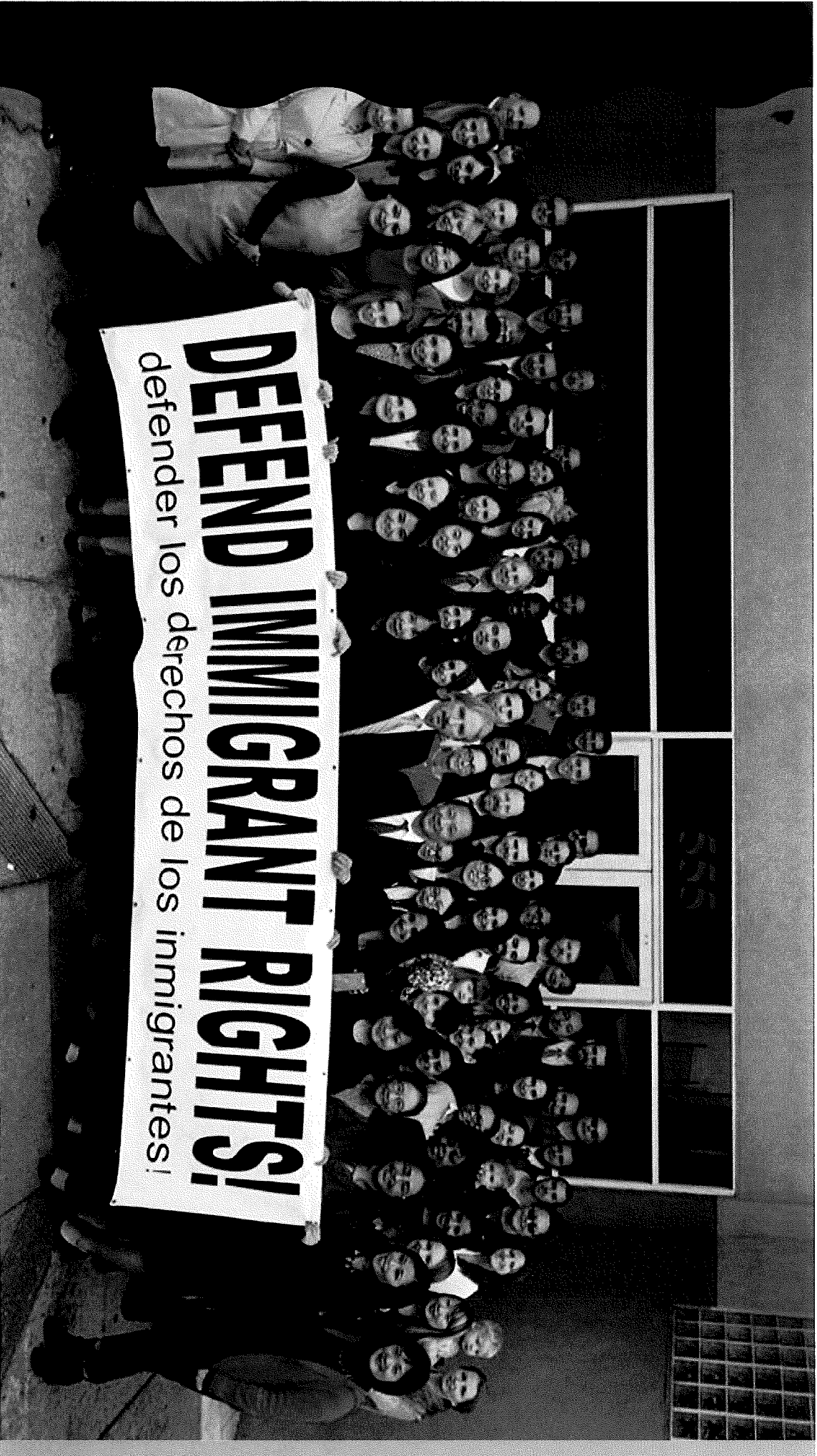

SF PUBLIC DEFENDER IMMIGRATION DEFENSE UNIT

- **Original Staffing Request: 10 Attorneys
(400-600 cases) and 5 Paralegals, 2
Senior Legal Process Clerks**
- **Current Staffing: 3 Limited Tenure Attorneys
(120-180 cases) and 1 Paralegal**

SOCIAL WORKERS

- Increased demand due to Props 47 & 66
- Office has 5 social workers in adult division and 5 in juvenile division
- Seeking 2 additional adult social worker and 1 juvenile social worker
- Study shows \$5.2 million saved

DIGITIZATION OF PAPERLESS FILES

- Currently only initial discovery package is digitized.
- Department needs 2 additional clerks to digitize documents generated by attorneys and defense team.
- SAVINGS: Storage & copying costs & more efficient use of staff time
