Cleared 26,073 tons of debris from the streets and sidewalks through April 2019

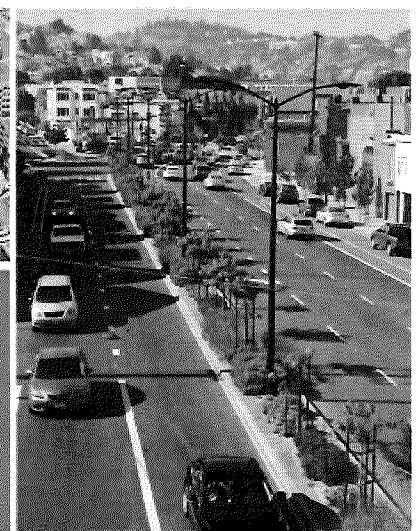
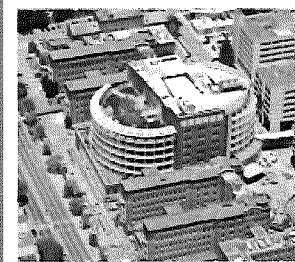
Expanded the Pit Stop Program to 25 locations, with 272,650 uses or 45,441 monthly uses in first six months

11 mobile Pit Stops currently operating,
7 new mobile Pit Stops proposed

- Portables operate 7 hours per day,
5 days a week.
- Adding new locations and expanding days
and hours of operation

12 JC Decaux Pit Stops

- Currently locations are staffed
11 hours per day, 7 days per week.

2 Rec Park Restroom Locations

32 Proposed Pit Stop Locations

- Public Works: four new 7355 Truck Drivers
- Workforce Development: 30 new monitors

Street Cleaning : Block Sweeping Program Expansion

SOMA Clean - \$297,500

- Adding weekend service: 10 am to 2 pm, 7 days per week
- 3 workforce development positions

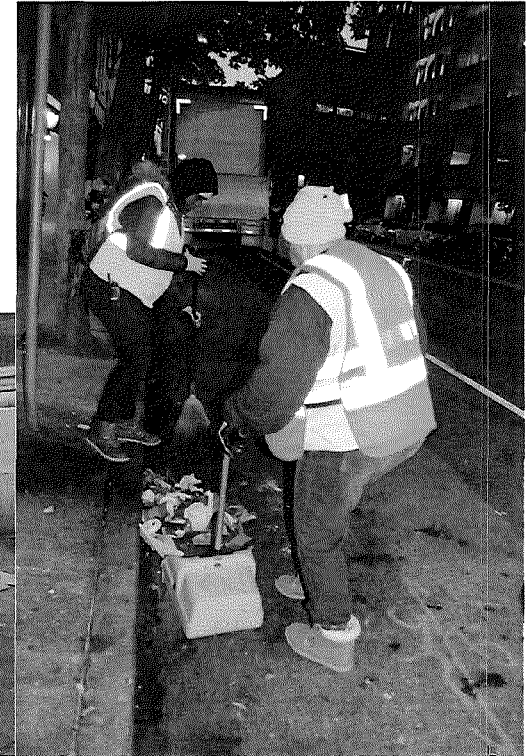
Tenderloin Clean - \$777,500

- Adding weekend service: 5 am to 9 am, and 3 pm to 8 pm 7 days per week
- 10 workforce development positions

Chinatown Clean - \$240,000

- Adding steam cleaning services
- 2 workforce development positions

Total Expansion Budget: \$1,315,000



Public Works Initiatives

Improving project delivery

- 8 off-budget positions to support planned improvements to parks, recreation centers, homeless shelters and navigation centers
- 2 off-budget positions to accelerate abatement of hazardous materials

Expediting housing development

- 7 new off-budget positions to shorten the approval time for new housing in development areas

Growing the urban forest

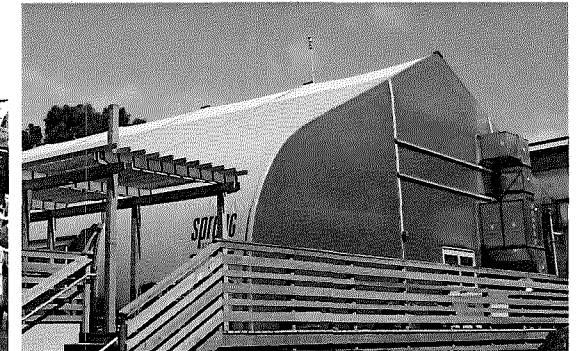
- \$2 million to replace trees in existing basins

Supporting healthy streets

- 1 dispatcher and 1 manager for daily operations for the Healthy Streets Operation Center

Greening the fleet

- 8 replacement sweepers to continue the greening of our existing fleet

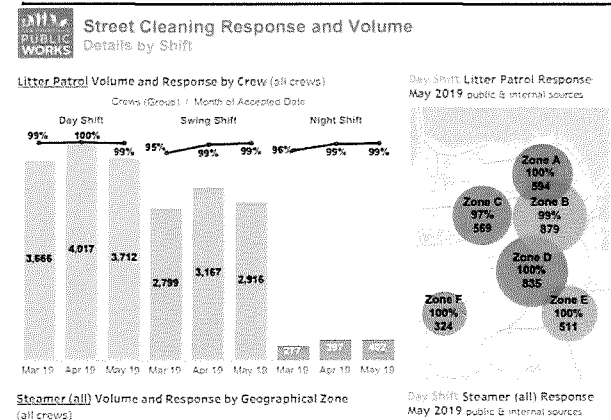

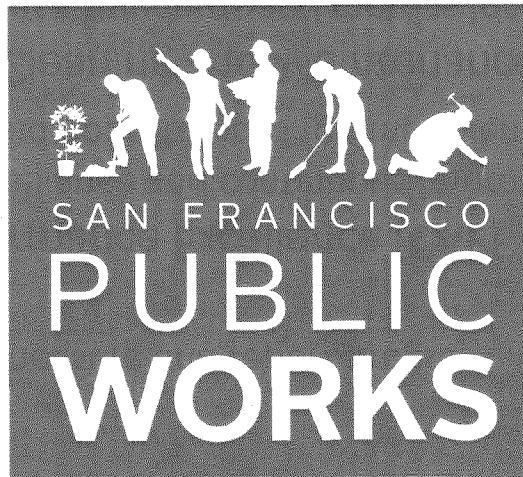
Pursuing a California Award for Performance Excellence (CAPE) and National Baldrige Award
