3	Resolution establishing contra flow bicycle lanes on the east side of Polk Street from
4	Market Street to McAllister Street.
5	
6	WHEREAS, It is a goal of the City and County of San Francisco to provide a safe and
7	continuous bicycle network to destinations throughout the City; and
8	WHEREAS, There is a worsening physical inactivity and obesity crisis in the United
9	States, with looming impacts on disease rates and health care costs; and,
10	WHEREAS, Bicycling and walking as part of an every day routine are simple and easy
11	ways to exercise and reduce the risk of heart attacks, stroke, and diabetes; and,
12	WHEREAS, Global climate change is a real and looming threat to our economy, our
13	public health and our environment; and,
14	WHEREAS, The transportation sector is the fastest growing source of carbon dioxide
15	emissions in the United States; and
16	WHEREAS, Establishing bicycle lanes throughout the City have increased bicycle
17	mode share on those streets by an average of 50%, benefiting cyclists by providing dedicated
18	roadway space, motorists by relieving congestion, and San Francisco residents in general by
19	improving safety on City streets, and reducing air pollution including greenhouse gas
20	emissions; and
21	WHEREAS, the Department of Parking and Traffic, in collaboration with the San
22	Francisco Bicycle Coalition and San Francisco County Transportation Authority, has recently
23	undertaken an unprecedented community planning process to update San Francisco's Bicycle
24	Plan; and
25	

1	WHEREAS, A series of high priority projects were identified from input received by the
2	public and the establishment of a contra-flow lane on Polk Street is identified as one of these
3	top tier projects; and
4	WHEREAS, The existing bicycle lanes on Polk Street between McAllister Street and
5	Post Street have increased bicycling by more than 40%; and
6	WHEREAS, City Hall and existing Polk Street bicycle lanes are difficult to access from
7	Market Street by bicycle, because of a one-way restriction on the southern end of Polk Street
8	and
9	WHEREAS, Contra-flow bicycle lanes are in use in many jurisdictions, including San
10	Francisco's Presidio, Santa Cruz, Eugene, Oregon, Cambridge, Massachusetts, Madison,
11	Wisconsin; and
12	WHEREAS, The provision of contra-flow lanes where there has been a history of
13	sidewalk or wrong way bicycle riding has improved safety and reduced conflicts between
14	bicycles and motor vehicles; and
15	WHEREAS, This plan is in accordance with the San Francisco General Plan, and will
16	improve safety and accessibility for bicyclists as well as pedestrians, autos, and transit
17	vehicles; now therefore be it
18	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco in
19	accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic
20	Code, hereby authorizes the following regulation governing the establishment of bicycle lanes
21	on Polk Street:

23	Polk Street, east side from Market Street to McAllister Street
