5 Ordinance appropriating \$6,816,953, including \$6,353,453 of General Fund balance,
6 \$320,000 of property tax revenues, \$40,000 of administrative processing fees, and
7 \$103,500 of Federal Medi-Cal Title XIX revenues, and appropriating \$5,470,339 for
8 various programs in the Department of Children, Youth, and Their Families and
9 \$1,346,614 for various programs in Human Services Agency – Department of Aging and
10 Adult Services for FY2010-2011, and urging the First Five Commission to program at
11 least \$693,000 of existing appropriation authority for Early Childcare and Education
12 programs, requiring a two-thirds affirmative vote of all members of the Board of
13 Supervisors per San Francisco Charter Section 9.113.

18 Section 3. In addition to the services funded under this Supplemental, the Board of

19 Supervisors urges the First Five Commission to program at least \$693,000 of existing

20 appropriation authority for community-based services for Early Childcare and Education

21 programs.

23 Section 4. The Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Annual Appropriation Ordinance includes the rejection

24 of \$6,816,953 of various programs in Children, Youth, and Their Families and the Human

25 Services Agency – Department of Aging and Adult Services by the Mayor, which is subject to

1 appropriation in this legislation. Pursuant to Charter Section 9.113, the funding of any item
2 previously rejected by the Mayor or the Board of Supervisors in consideration of the annual
3 budget shall require a two-thirds vote of all members of the Board of Supervisors for approval.
4 Therefore, the appropriation of \$6,816,953 within this appropriation is subject to a two-thirds
5 affirmative vote of all members of the Board of Supervisors.
